

DashCon 2 Terms and Conditions



These are the terms (the “Agreement”) that govern your attendance at and/or participation in a DASHCON TWO Event (collectively referred to herein as “DashCon 2” or “Event”), taking place at the Japanese Canadian Cultural Centre (the “Premises”) located at 6 Sakura Way, Toronto ON, Canada.

By registering for DashCon 2, you are agreeing to these terms, which form a legal contract between DASHCON TWO, and the registered attendee and/or participant (“you”). If you are registering on behalf of another, it is your responsibility to ensure that the person attending is aware of these terms and accepts them, and by completing the registration you are warranting that you have made the attendee aware of these terms and that they have accepted these terms.

1. Event Admission

1.1. Your registration entitles you to admittance to the Event. Any and all other costs associated with your attendance (including without limitation any travel and/or accommodation expenses) shall be borne solely by you and DASHCON TWO shall have no liability for such costs.

1.2. You acknowledge and agree that DASHCON TWO, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to change any and all aspects of the Event, including but not limited to, the Event name, themes, content, program, speakers, performers, hosts, moderators, venue and time.

1.3. By attending the Event you acknowledge and agree to grant DASHCON TWO the right to record, film, photograph or capture your likeness in any media now available and hereafter developed and to distribute, broadcast, use or otherwise globally to disseminate, in perpetuity, such media without any further approval from you or any payment to you. This grant to DASHCON TWO includes, but is not limited to, the right to

edit such media, the right to use the media alone or together with other information, and the right to allow others to use and/or disseminate the media.

1.4. You acknowledge that DASHCON TWO reserves the right to request your removal from the Event if DASHCON TWO, in its sole discretion, considers your presence and/or behaviour to create a disruption or to hinder the Event and/or the enjoyment of the Event by other attendees or speakers.

1.5. Each individual must have an individual registration. Wristbands are not to be shared.

1.6. Admission is restricted to persons 13 years and over. Children under 13 will not be permitted onsite.

1.7. DASHCON TWO reserves the right to decline the registration of any applicant.

2. Fee(s)

2.1. The payment of the applicable fee(s) for the Event is due upon registration. If such payment is insufficient or declined for any reason DASHCON TWO may refuse to admit you to the Event and shall have no liability in that regard.

2.2. The fee(s) may be subject to sales tax, value added tax, or any other taxes and duties which, if applicable, will be charged to you in addition to the fee(s).

3. Refund Policy

3.1. Refunds must be requested by email to registration@dashcontwo.com before 1st June 2025. Admissions purchased after 1st June 2025 are non-refundable.

3.2. Refunds will be sent back to your credit card through Simpli Events. Fees taken by Simpli Events or the transaction processing service Stripe are non-refundable.

3.3. A \$10 CAD processing fee will be charged for all refund requests.

3.4. No refunds or credits shall be issued for "no shows," cancellations, substitutions, or for any other reason, including without limitation, interruption, postponement, cancellation or relocation of the convention due to any cause determined by convention management to be beyond management's control.

4. Intellectual Property

4.1. All intellectual property rights in and to the Event, the Event content and all materials distributed at or in connection with the Event are owned by DASHCON TWO and/or the Event speakers or companies presenting at the Event. You may not use or

reproduce or allow anyone to use or reproduce any trademarks (including without limitation the Event brand or other trade names appearing at the Event), any Event content and/or any materials distributed at or in connection with the Event for any reason without the prior written permission of DASHCON TWO.

5. Warranties and Limitation of Liability

5.1. DASHCON TWO gives no warranties in respect of any aspect of the Event or any materials related thereto or offered at the Event and, to the fullest extent possible under the laws governing this Agreement, disclaims all implied warranties, including but not limited to warranties of fitness for a particular purpose, accuracy, timeliness and merchantability. Neither DASHCON TWO nor its affiliates can accept any responsibility or liability for reliance by you or any person on any aspect of the Event and/or any information provided at the Event.

5.2. Other than to the extent required as a matter of law: (i) neither DASHCON TWO nor its affiliates shall be liable for any direct, indirect, special, incidental, or consequential costs, damages or losses arising directly or indirectly from the Event or other aspect related thereto or in connection with this Agreement.

5.3. The maximum aggregate liability of DASHCON TWO for any claim in any way connected with therewith or this Agreement whether in contract, tort or otherwise (including any negligent act or omission) shall be limited to the amount paid by you to DASHCON TWO under this Agreement to attend the Event.

6. DASHCON TWO Rights

6.1. DASHCON TWO reserves the right, in its sole and unfettered discretion to: change (i) or modify the layout of the Event and/or relocate the event, conference sessions, exhibits or Exhibitors; (ii) cancel, in whole or in part, the Event due to an event of force majeure; or (iii) change the date, location and duration of the Event; without any liability to DASHCON TWO. DASHCON TWO shall endeavor to reschedule but the attendee hereby indemnifies and holds harmless from and against any and all costs, damages and expenses, including attorney fees, which are incurred by the applicant.

7. Force Majeure

7.1. In the event that (i) the facility in which the Event is to be held or is held is destroyed or becomes unavailable for occupancy or (ii) DASHCON TWO is unable to permit any attendees to occupy the facility or the space, or (iii) if the Event is cancelled or curtailed,

for any reasons beyond the control of DASHCON TWO, including but not limited to, casualty, explosion, fire, lightning, flood, weather, epidemic, earthquake or other Acts of God, acts of public enemies, riots or civil disturbances, strike, lockout or boycott, DASHCON TWO will not be responsible for any loss of business, loss of profits, consequential or special damages or expenses of whatever nature that the attendee may suffer.

8. Consent

8.1. By choosing I consent to receiving CEM's (commercial electronic messages) regarding the Event by DASHCON TWO, you give your express consent to receiving email or HTML communications from us regarding updates to the Event you registered for and any other convention DASHCON TWO organizes. You may choose to unsubscribe at any time.

9. Conduct and Fines for Misconduct

9.1. Attendees are expected to behave respectfully and refrain from damaging (including but not limited to breaking, urinating, defecating, or otherwise soiling) event property, including but not limited to the furniture, artwork, inflatables, ball pit, or any other material good on the Premises.

9.2. In the event that damage is caused by an attendee, DASHCON TWO reserves the right to levy a fine of up to \$1000 Canadian Dollars and to request your removal from the Event.

10. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

10.1. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the province of Ontario and the federal laws of Canada. Canadian courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any claim brought by you arising from, or related to the use of these Terms & Conditions.
